You make me feel Leic dancing LEICA SL2-S REPORTER

For fans of the early-'90s breakbeat scene, just seeing the name 'SL2' will immediately have them singing *On a Ragga Tip*. Leica's latest snapper, which is limited to 1000 units, might have nothing to do with DJ Slipmatt, but its rugged all-metal body and scratch-resistant paint should at least make it raveproof. Inside it has a 24.6MP full-frame sensor that's capable of 25fps continuous shooting and 4K @ 60fps recording with no limit to the footage length. The L-mount system supports Leica's own lenses as well as glass from Panasonic and Sigma, and its chassis is cloaked in aramid fibre to add toughness and grip – so unlike the dancefloor, it's not so susceptible to drops.

Fold me 'til the morning comes MOTOROLA RAZR 2022

While Nokia reboots its classic phones as sub-£100 burners, Motorola's newest reborn Razr goes toe-to-toe with the best. Powered by a Snapdragon 8+ Gen 1 CPU, the 6.7in OLED display inside the new folding Moto offers 10-bit colour, HDR10+ video playback and a 144Hz refresh rate – that's faster than you'll find on any other foldable. On the outside, the 2.7in extra display – flanked by a 50MP optically stabilised main camera and a 13MP ultrawide sensor with autofocus – has a handful of new widgets, so you won't have to flip the phone open so often. And the battery's had a boost to 3500mAh too, so you shouldn't have to plug it in as regularly as the old Razr 5G.
